Eligibility

Theme

Water in everyday life

Categories

Two categories: 1) Color and 2) Black & White

Photo Requirements

Photos must be taken within Helix Water District's service area during the 2019-2020 school year and depict this year's theme.

Photos may be in color or black & white. Each student may submit up to two photos in each category for a total of four submissions.

Photos must be in JPEG form, 10 MB or less and 300 PPI resolution. Photos may be horizontal or landscape.

Photos may be edited for minor adjustments only.

How to Enter

Email photo(s), completed entry form(s) and image release(s), if applicable, to education@helixwater.org

Due by 5 p.m. on Friday, January 31, 2020

A separate entry form is required for each entered photo. Entry forms must be physically signed - no electronic signatures - by the student and guardian, if under 18 years old.

Photos showing recognizable individuals must submit a signed image release for each person. Blank forms are available at hwd.fyi/HSphotocontest

Judging

Judging will be performed by a panel of Helix Water District staff. Judging criteria is adherence to the year's theme, visual appeal, technical quality and creativity.
