Rules

- Photos must be taken at Lake Jennings from March 1 through May 31, 2021.
- Photos may be in color or black & white.
- Photos must be in JPEG format and high resolution, with a minimum of 1,300 pixels on the longest side.
- Limit of three photo submissions per photographer.
- Photos may be edited for minor adjustments only and must retain a natural and realistic appearance.
- Photos may not contain watermarks.
- Photos and all usage rights become the property of Helix Water District.
- Employees of Helix Water District and their immediate families, including spouses, grandparents, parents, siblings, children and grandchildren, are ineligible to win.

How to Enter

Submit a completed and signed entry form for each entered photo.

Photos showing recognizable individuals must submit a signed image release for each person. Blank forms are available at

Free Photographer's Day-Pass

Lake Jennings is offering free admission to photographers during March, April and May for participation in the contest.

Lake Jennings recreation area is open Friday through Sunday; check the lake's website for current hours. Only registered campers may access the campground at this time. All visitors must comply with current county of San Diego health orders.

Photographers must check in at the Bait & Tackle Shop to obtain a free day-pass for the purpose of photographing for the competition.

Photographer pass does not permit fishing. If you wish to fish, regular fishing permit fees apply. See fee schedule at www.lakejennings.org.

There is no parking along the campground road. To photograph along the campground road, park in a designated parking spot and walk down.

At the direction of staff, photographers may be required to move their equipment due to safety or accessibility concerns.
